

Rules of Play | Lottery Licence #RAF1247749

A description of how each game is played

The lottery will take place online only, beginning Wednesday, June 1, 2022 at 12:00 am. Tickets may be purchased from www.stjoeslottery.ca. Purchasers must be 18 years of age or older to participate, and must be located in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase.

Tickets will be sold using an electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions. After purchase, participants will receive a confirmation e-mail with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. Ticket numbers are generated randomly so specific numbers can not be requested by purchasers.

The prize amount of the 50/50 will be updated in real-time on the lottery website: www.stjoeslottery.ca.

By purchasing a ticket, you agree to allow us, St. Joseph's Healthcare Foundation, Hamilton, and its licensed gaming suppliers providing services to this program, the right, if you are a prize winner, to use and publicly disclose your name, municipality of residence, image, photograph and likeness as a prize winner in any means required by the terms of our lottery license and/or that we consider appropriate for purposes of administering and promoting the lottery, without notice, review or approval or additional compensation to you.

The lottery will have one (1) Early Bird Prize and one (1) Grand Prize which will be awarded according to the amounts and timelines below.

A representative of St. Joseph's Healthcare Foundation Hamilton will contact the winner of each draw by phone and/or email.

Regulations prohibit the following individuals and their immediate family members residing in the same household from participating in the lottery: St. Joseph's Healthcare Foundation Hamilton Staff and Board of Directors, St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton Executive Team and Joint Board of Governors, St. Joseph's Health System Board of Directors, employees of Ascend Fundraising Solutions, and members of licenced gaming suppliers providing services to the Lottery. Employees of St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton are permitted to purchase tickets, provided the above regulations do not apply.

Prize values for each game

The Early Bird Prize will be **\$1,000**. All tickets purchased by 11:59 pm on Tuesday, June 14, 2022 will be eligible to win. The winner will be drawn and announced at Noon on Wednesday, June 15, 2022.

The Grand Prize will be equal to 50% of the gross ticket sale revenues. There will be a guaranteed grand prize of **\$8,999**. All tickets purchased by 11:59 pm on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 will be eligible to win. The winner will be drawn and announced at Noon on Wednesday, June 29, 2022.

Total value of guaranteed prizing, including Early Bird prize = **\$9,999**.

Quantity and price of fixed prize raffle tickets to be sold, if applicable

There is no maximum number of tickets to be sold.

Tickets are sold in packages, at the following price points:

- 10 tickets for \$10
- 40 tickets for \$20
- 160 tickets for \$40
- 300 tickets for \$60

Methods for determining winners

For all prizes including the Early Bird Prize and Grand Prize, the winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw. The system is supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.

Selection of a ticket number as the winning ticket of the Early Bird Prize, will NOT cause this ticket number to be removed from contention for the Grand Prize. Therefore, it is possible that the same participant may win more than one prize, should one of their ticket number(s) be selected by the system in more than one draw.

Each winner must arrange to collect their prize in person at St. Joseph's Healthcare Foundation. At this time the winner must provide their name, address, and phone number as well as a piece of photo ID, and the email receipt with their winning lottery ticket number on it for verification.

Once the winner is verified, they will be awarded their prize by cheque and will have their photograph taken. By entering this lottery, the winner consents to the use of their name and photograph for advertising and publicity purposes.

Each winning ticket holder has 6 months during which to claim their prize from the date of the draw. Unclaimed prizes will be reported, and a charitable allocation will be approved by AGCO.

Methods for concluding a game that does not proceed as intended or approved

Each draw concludes with one winner being selected in a controlled environment, selected electronically by Ascend Fundraising Solutions' 50/50 solution.

Responsible gambling

Each ticket will list the ConnexOntario website and problem gambling helpline. This contact information will also be accessible to all lottery players via the lottery website (the sole method to purchase tickets) and in the email confirmation sent to purchasers. Per Ascend, placement of this information in their digital materials has been approved by AGCO.
